Proceedings:

Deadline for paper submission is August 29, 2018.

The conference proceedings will be published in international journals:

- 1) Ferroelectrics (on ferroics)
- 2) IOP Conference Series: Materials Science and Engineering

The manuscripts should be submitted in electronic format (including separate electronic files of each of the figures) together with one hardcopy printout exactly matching the electronic version. These copies should be delivered in person to the registration desk at the conference and should be clearly marked with the reference number of the paper (Abstract Identification Code).

All the papers will be reviewed during or after the conference. Each presentation allows the authors to submit only one manuscript for publication. Although authors can submit two abstracts and one paper for each abstract, only one paper is covered by registration fee. The second paper to IOP Conference Series should be additionally paid for.

Venue:

The conference will be held in the building of Institute of Natural Sciences and Mathematics, Ural Federal University (Kuibysheva str., 48). The conference sessions will be held in the conference hall on the 7th floor. Ferroelectric laboratory and Center for Shared Use "Modern Nanotechnologies" are situated on the 1st and 2nd floors.

Visa:

To enter Russia, you will need a passport and, in most cases, a visa.

In order to obtain a Russian visa, you will need an official invitation.

To draw up the official invitation letter for visa we need:

1. Copy of the first page of passport (with photo).

Please, note that your passport should be valid for at least 6 months after intended departure date from Russia and should have at least 2 blank visa-designated pages.

2. Filled form.

Please, send these two files to the local organizing committee by e-mail: spm-2018@labfer.ru Deadline for official visa invitation request is:

June 10, 2018 for European Union countries and China

May 10, 2018 for other countries.

There is another option of fast obtaining the invitation for tourist visa via several Ekaterinburg hotels.
